"Job's 'Covenant' With God"

PART 1:

It was in the beginning that God instituted sacrifice for sin:

Genesis 3:21 KJV

(21) Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.

He covered man's sin with the pelts of an animal, or animals, which were killed for their sin.

Hebrews 9:22 KJV

(22) And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

This principle was also from the beginning:

Without shedding of blood, there was no forgiveness of sin, and no release from the penalty of sin, which was the separation of man from God.

Although Adam and Eve were so covered with unnamed animals' skins, however, not long afterward, their son Abel was found to be a keeper of sheep, and then sacrificed from his flock, which was pleasing to God.

Genesis 4:1-4 KJV

- (1) And Adam knew Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bore Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the LORD.
- (2) And she again bore his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.
- (3) And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD.
- (4) And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering:

We can, then, also see that this continued for thousands of years, as Abraham had also sacrificed sheep:

Genesis 22:7-8,13 KJV

- (7) And Isaac spoke unto Abraham his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here *am* I, my son. And he said, Behold the fire and the wood: but where *is* the lamb for a burnt offering?
- (8) And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.
- (13) And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind *him* a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.

So, since Job is said to be the oldest book in the Bible, and is considered to have been before the Torah (i.e., Law of Moses) was instituted - as being the former Covenant, therefore - it is most likely that Job followed this God-prescribed atonement for sin, and thus sacrificed sheep, for his sons and daughters, in obedience to God; this is the most likely reason why God, Himself, said of Job that he was "upright" and "perfect," and that he "feared God."

And God also considered Job "[His] servant".

Job 1:1,8; 2:3 KJV

- (1:1) There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job; and that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil.
- (1:8) And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil?

(2:3) And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him without cause.

And, calling Job again His servant, after God brought Job back from devastation, sickness, pain, and torments, He, God, pronounced what Job was to sacrifice on behalf of the sin of his three so-called "friends":

Job 42:8-10 KJV

- (8) Therefore take unto you now seven bullocks and seven rams, and go to my servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and my servant Job shall pray for you: for him will I accept: lest I deal with you *after your* folly, in that ye have not spoken of me *the thing which is* right, like my servant Job.
- (9) So Eliphaz the Temanite and Bildad the Shuhite *and* Zophar the Naamathite went, and did according as the LORD commanded them: the LORD also accepted Job.
- (10) And the LORD turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before.

So, since God had Job offer bulls and rams, which are male sheep, it is most likely that Job's "Covenant" with God was merely that he offered sheep for his children, his wife, and himself to "eschew evil" - which means to "turn away badness" according to Strong's Hebrew Dictionary.

I'm not saying that Job actually had a Covenant with God, per se, but rather, that he was doing as was passed on to him from former generations, even as was taught to Adam and Abel, and later, passed down to Abraham too.

This is why God asked satan if he had "considered" His servant Job, that he was perfect and upright, etc. The word "considered," in the Hebrew, actually means to "put to the heart;" satan had not "taken to heart" what Job was doing *from his heart* before God!

God let satan do his nefarious will toward Job simply because God believed in Job, despite satan's accusations that he would curse Him to His face if he were to be stricken!

You will note that God, Himself, stated that satan had "moved [Him] against [Job] to destroy him." But God had NOT been so "moved;" instead, He allowed Job to be "PROVED" before satan's eyes!

PART 2:

Here are a couple Scriptural citations to support my ending remarks about Job's "Covenant" with reference to my saying that God was only "PROVING" Job:

God was NOT destroying Job; He was also not MOVED AGAINST HIM to do so! I contend that he was merely PROVING Job before satan.

First, consider this:

Revelation 12:10 KJV

(10) And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

Surely, satan accused GOD, AND Job, as is seen in these verses:

Job 1:9-11 KJV

(9) Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, Doth Job fear God for naught?

- (10) Hast not thou made a hedge about him, and about his house, and about all that he hath on every side? thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his substance is increased in the land.
- (11) But put forth thine hand now, and touch all that he hath, and he will curse thee to thy face.

and then, again:

Job 2:3-5 KJV

- (3) And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him without cause.
- (4) And Satan answered the LORD, and said, Skin for skin, yea, all that a man hath will be give for his life.
- (5) But put forth thine hand now, and touch his bone and his flesh, and he will curse thee to thy face.

In this manner, satan accused God of hedging Job in, protecting him from harm and ruin, and that God was keeping Job healthy – and that, for His doing THAT, He was shetering Job; and, in both cases, he was accusing Job of being cottled by God, and accusing him of living a care-free life that was merely a façade of "being God's servant." Satan was stating that, if Job had either of these things taken from him, he would lose his "so-called integrity!"

The accuser of the brethren attacked BOTH OF THEM – Job AND GOD –for their integrity! And God intended fully to PROVE that Job was TRULY His "faithful servant" and would NOT do as satan accused him of that he would do instead!

This is consistent with what God did with the Israelites; look at these verses of the Torah:

Exodus 16:4 KJV

(4) Then said the LORD unto Moses, Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you; and the people shall go out and gather a certain rate every day, **that I may prove them**, **whether they will walk in my law, or no**.

Exodus 20:20 KJV

(20) And Moses said unto the people, Fear not: for God is come to prove you, and that his fear may be before your faces, that ye sin not.

Deuteronomy 8:2 KJV

(2) And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or not.

Deuteronomy 8:16 KJV

(16) Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might humble thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end;

NOTICE THAT LAST VERSE'S ENDING:

"...to do thee GOOD AT THY LATTER END!"

THAT is what God was doing to - and for - Job, and that was what He was simultaneously showing satan: that satan, himself, was - contrarily - corrupt in his own heart!

You will note that, in the New Covenant in Christ, God doesn't prove us any longer: RATHER, WE ARE TO PROVE OUR OWN SELVES!!!

Look here:

Romans 12:2 KJV

(2) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that **ye may prove** what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

2Corinthians 13:5 KJV

(5) Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; **prove your own selves**. Know ye not your own selves, **how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates**?

Galatians 6:4 KJV

(4) But <u>let every man prove his own work</u>, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another.

1Thessalonians 5:21 KJV

(21) Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.

So, you see, God gave us the Holy Spirit to enable us to PROVE OURSELVES that we are IN THE FAITH, and that we are also SONS OF GOD – NOT JUST SERVANTS (but ALL THE MORE being "Servants of God," *resultant of* our being HIS SONS!)

Here is what God was allowing satan to do to Job [I use small letters for satan to denote how small he is in my eyes!]:

2Timothy 3:12 KJV

(12) Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.

John 16:33 KJVR

(33) These things I [JESUS] have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

Acts 14:22 KJV

(22) Confirming the souls of the disciples, *and* exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God.

1Thessalonians 3:4 KJV

(4) For verily, when we were with you, we told you before that we should suffer tribulation; even as it came to pass, and ye know.

Revelation 1:9 KJV

(9) I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

IN ALL OUR TRIALS & PERSECUTIONS, WE ARE PROVED AS HIS SONS, DISCIPLES, AND SERVANTS!

Job was merely proved as being a faithful servant of God, and, for being such, God DOUBLY BLESSED Job's LATTE R END!

ALL THE MORE, **WE** HAVE EVERY SPIRITUAL BLESSING IN CHRIST; AND OUR LATTER END IS FORETOLD, AS LONG AS WE DO NOT SHRINK BACK – THUS BEING DESTROYED INSTEAD - BUT RATHER, THAT WE ENDURE TO THE END AND ARE, THEREFORE, SAVED!!!

Ephesians 1:3 KJV

(3) Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with **all** spiritual blessings in heavenly *places* in Christ:

Hebrews 10:38-39 KJV

- (38) Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.
- (39) But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.

Jude 1:5 KJV

(5) I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.

1Corinthians 10:5-11 KJV

- (5) But with many of them God was not well pleased: for they were overthrown in the wilderness.
- (6) Now these things were our examples, to the intent we should not lust after evil things, as they also lusted.
- (7) Neither be ye idolaters, as *were* some of them; as it is written, The people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play.
- (8) Neither let us commit fornication, as some of them committed, and fell in one day three and twenty thousand.
- (9) Neither let us tempt Christ, as some of them also tempted, and were destroyed of serpents.
- (10) Neither murmur ye, as some of them also murmured, and were destroyed of the destroyer.
- (11) Now all these things happened unto them for examples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.

Matthew 24:8-13 KJVR

- (8) [JESUS STATED] All these are the beginning of sorrows.
- (9) **Then** shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake.
- (10) And **then** shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.
- (11) And many false prophets **shall** rise, and **shall** deceive many.
- (12) And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- (13) But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

Mark 13:13 KJVR

(13) [JESUS STATED] And ye shall be hated of all *men* for my name's sake: **but he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved**.

The message therein is PROVE YOUR OWN SELVES, as is written in THESE words, which follow 1Corinthians 10:11...

1Corinthians 10:12 KJV

(12) Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall.

Even Paul, himself, proved his own self to be sure that he was "in the faith;" look here:

1Corinthians 9:24-27 KJV

- (24) Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? **So run, that ye may obtain**.
- (25) And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible.
- (26) I therefore so run, not as uncertainly; so fight I, not as one that beateth the air:
- (27) But <u>I keep under my body</u>, and bring it into subjection: <u>lest that by any means</u>, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

I reiterate what PAUL THE APOSTLE said, citing verse 27:

"...lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway."

The word "castaway," in the Greek, is the word "adokimos, as given by Strong's"; it is interpreted as meaning:

unapproved;

rejected;

worthless.

The same word is used elsewhere in the New Testament as "reprobate"; this is what "reprobate" is defined as, according to Noah Webster:

- 1. Not enduring proof or trial; not of standard purity or fineness; disallowed; rejected.
- 2. Abandoned in sin; lost to virtue or grace.
- 3. Abandoned to error, or in apostasy. 2 Timothy 3.

Here is what 2Timothy, Chapter 3, that Noah Webster cites, states:

2Timothy 3:1-8 KJV

- (1) This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.
- (2) For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,
- (3) Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,
- (4) Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;
- (5) Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.
- (6) For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts,
- (7) Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.
- (8) Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, <u>reprobate concerning the faith</u>.

[EMPHASES ARE MINE]

EVEN PAUL BELIEVED HE COULD BECOME A REPROBATE AND LOSE HIS OWN SALVATION!!!

<u>THAT IS A WARNING</u>...TO REMAIN VIGILANT, <u>TO BE FAITHFUL UNTO GOD</u> THE FATHER BY JESUS CHRIST, *BY ABIDING IN THE HOLY SPIRIT - AT ALL TIMES!!*

I hope this is all *encouragement* to every one of you that read this, as THAT is what Job's "Covenant" with God IS REALLY ABOUT!!!

PART 3:

I realized that I'd forgotten to specify exactly what I believe regarding what exactly God means to do to "prove" Job by what he experienced. Here is what I have to say about the matter:

First, as I said before in my last message on the subject, God was NOT "moved against" Job, NOR did He intend to "de stroy" him! As I said, He merely was "proving" Job.

But I didn't say HOW that was to occur!

Let me start by stating, emphatically, that GOD DID **NOT** MAKE JOB SICK, **NOR** DID HE DESTROY HIS HOME AND KILL HIS SERVANTS, **NOR** DID HE KILL HIS KIDS!

In fact, God merely ALLOWED satan to carry out what he, satan, intended against Job by NOT STOPPING, NOR FORBIDDING him TO DO SO!

God COULD HAVE stopped that!

NOTHING is by any means IMPOSSIBLE with God, including – and especially – causing the enemy to "cease and desist" from his plans!

God ALLOWED Job to experience those things to "prove" him: to prove him before satan, himself, before his remaining family, before his 3 "comforters" (i.e., so-called "friends"), and before all of his peers in his city!

He also "proved" Job by drawing out of his heart what he, Job, believed about God...by hearing what he would SAY, and by seeing what he would DO, in response to his calamities! (NOT that GOD didn't know that, but that JOB would come to see what was in his own heart!)

Yes, Job had started out the wrong way:

He stated, "That which I GREATLY FEARED has COME UPON ME!" (paraphrased)

Job 3:25 KJV

(25) For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me.

Job doubted that God would protect him from calamity and illness...so, inevitably, he had INVITED BOTH from satan's hand, simply by expressing fear of those sorrows!

FEAR is the OPPOSITE of FAITH;

BUT, FEAR draws the RESULT of FAITH, ALBEIT ONLY IN THE NEGATIVE! In other words, FEAR is NEGATIVE FAITH!

Job RECEIVED the results of his FEARFULNESS, and GOD THEREFORE ALLOWED IT TO COME TO HIM SO AS TO REVEAL WHAT WAS IN HIS HEART: REGARDING GOD'S PROTECTION, AND WITH REGARD TO GOD'S SALVATION FROM CALAMITY & DISEASE!

(I *think* Moses was the author of Psalm 91 – not certain; it *may* have been King David.) Here is what "whoever penned that Psalm" had to say about exactly what Job had feared:

Psalm 91:1-11,14-16 KJV

- (1) He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- (2) I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.
- (3) Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.
- (4) He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth *shall be thy* shield and buckler.
- (5) Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;
- (6) Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness: nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.
- (7) A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.
- (8) Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.
- (9) Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;
- (10) There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come night by dwelling.
- (11) For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.
- (14) Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.
- (15) He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I *will be* with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honor him.
- (16) With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation.

I also like the way the New International Version states verses 9-10:

Psalm 91:9-10 NIV

- (9) If you say, "The LORD is my refuge," and you make the Most High your dwelling,
- (10) no harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent.

Job experienced the exact OPPOSITE!

WHY?

BECAUSE he was AFRAID of THAT occurring!

God later BLESSED Job with DOUBLE EVERYTHING...because he *finally* put his TRUST in God:

Job 42:1-2,5-6 KJV

- (1) Then Job answered the LORD, and said,
- (2) I know that thou canst do every thing, and that no thought can be withheld from thee.
- (5) *I have heard of thee* by the hearing of the ear: but now mine eye seeth thee.
- (6) Wherefore I abhor *myself*, and <u>repent</u> in dust and ashes.

He turned from his fear to FAITH, and he repented of UNBELIEF!!!

Job SAW (verse 5) the AWESOMENESS of GOD ALMIGHTY in the end of the matter, and he then came to realize that God WAS, and IS, CAPABLE OF ALL THINGS (verse2)!

Job also realized that his own thoughts were not concealed from God (verse 2)...including, and especially, his FEAR, resultant of his DOUBT of GOD'S CAPABILITY TO PRESERVE, PROTECT, AND DELIVER HIM!

The point is NOT that God INTENDED evil to befall Job, but rather that Job DISBELIEVED GOD'S FAVOR AND MERCY OVER HIM AND ALL HE HAD!

God LET Job's fear of calamity overtake him by merely WITHHOLDING His PROHIBITION of the same from being enacted! He merely told satan the fact that, because Job was in UNBELIEF: "all that he has is in [satan's] hand":

Job 1:12 KJV

(12) And the LORD said unto Satan, Behold, all that he hath is in thy power; only upon himself put not forth thine hand. So Satan went forth from the presence of the LORD.

Yet, you can see that God DID enact His PROHIBITION to satan therein by stopping him from harming Job bodily!

Thereafter, it was sickness, merely because Job believed that GOD had taken away all that he had Himself:

Job 1:21-22 KJV

- (21) And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: **the LORD gave**, **and the LORD hath taken away**; **blessed be the name of the LORD**.
- (22) In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.

He had accepted that God could do whatever He wanted, including taking away His blessings and hedge of protection, so Job STILL blessed the Lord! Thereby, God did not count his words as sin, even if that is NOT how God works His will for us!

Even so, God did not count Job's response as being EVIL; rather, Job was merely UNBELIEVING...and what does Scripture say about that? See here:

Hebrews 11:6 KJV

(6) But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

So, with a later test, Job was further "proved" by God, Who simply withheld His Divine Health from him:

(NOTE THAT *HE MAY DO THIS TO US...*AS A MEANS TO HIS REWARDING US FOR OUR FAITH IN THE MIDST OF OUR, OR OTHERS', ILLNESSES!)

Job 2:4-6 KJV

- (4) And Satan answered the LORD, and said, Skin for skin, yea, all that a man hath will be give for his life.
- (5) But put forth thine hand now, and touch his bone and his flesh, and he will curse thee to thy face.
- (6) And the LORD said unto Satan, Behold, he is in thine hand; but save his life.

Notice that satan wanted to take Job's life, but GOD WOULD NOT ALLOW HIM THIS! However, He DID allow his BODY to be stricken with a plague of skin worms - and likely with some other illness, as his breath was also affected with a foul odor from it.

See here:

Job 2:7-8; 7:5; 19:26 KJV

- (2:7) So went Satan forth from the presence of the LORD, and **smote Job** with sore boils from the sole of his foot unto his crown.
- (2:8) And **he took him a potsherd to scrape himself** withal; and he sat down among the ashes.
- (7:5) My flesh is clothed with worms and clods of dust; my skin is broken, and become loathsome.
- (19:26) And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see God:

(Notice by his statement in verse 19:26 that Job believed in the resurrection, and that he would be counted worthy of it, incidentally!)

Job 19:17 KJV

(17) **My breath is strange to my wife**, though I entreated for the children's *sake* of mine own body.

The NIV says it this way:

Job 19:17 NIV

(17) My breath is offensive to my wife; I am loathsome to my own family.

God allowed ALL THESE THINGS to come upon Job, but NOT TO DESTROY HIM, but RATHER to REVEAL TO HIM WHO HE, GOD, IS - AND WILL, THEREAFTER, CONTINUE TO BE - TO AND FOR JOB!

AND THAT IS HIS MESSAGE FOR, AND TO, US TODAY!!!

By all of this, Job's heart was PROVED BY GOD...

...THROUGH THE FIRES OF AFFLICTION THAT HE'D ALLOWED THE DEVIL TO TRY HIM WITH!

GOD didn't TEMPT or TEST Job - SATAN did;

but God merely ALLOWED satan to go as far as he did to show Job THE TRUTH OF THE LORD'S BEING!!!

We receive Jesus and are spared the same testing of affliction and calamity, IF, AND ONLY IF, we remain in the faith that saved us in the first place!

(If not, we will LIKEWISE suffer at the hands of the devil.)

The only time we AREN'T spared is when GOD KNOWS SOMETHING AMISS IS IN OUR HEARTS AND WANTS TO DRAW IT OUT – THAT OUR LATTER END WILL BE BETTER THAN BEFORE!

Even though we have the baptism of the Holy Spirit, and we are truly HIS OWN CHILDREN, we, too, will experience similar undoings...until we, also, put our lives within His hands: to save, deliver, heal, protect, and provide for each of us who do!

I hope that all this has clarified my position on what it means to be "proved" by God...NOT that He SENDS or ADMINISTERS devastation, calamity, or sorrows and sicknesses, but that He merely LIFTS HIS HAND OF PRESERVATION AND DIVINE PROTECTION FROM THE SAME!

2Corinthians 4:16-18 KJV

- (16) For which cause **we faint not**; but <u>though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is</u> <u>renewed day by day</u>.
- (17) For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory;
- (18) While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.
